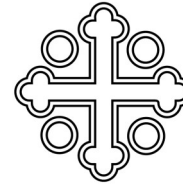
SUMMER LUNCH PROGRAM

Key Truth: God calls us to deny being self-serving and take up the cross of serving others.

Introduction:

Q: What moves you to consider the impact of your words and deeds on others?

Luke 3:7-14: Improving Upon Your Baptism: The Call to Bear Fruits in Keeping with Repentance:

“This is a truth which should always occupy a prominent place in our Christianity. It can never be impressed on our minds too strongly, that religious talking and profession are utterly worthless, without religious doing and practice. It is vain to say with our lips that we repent, if we do not at the same time repent with our lives. It is more than vain. It will gradually sear our consciences, and harden our hearts. To say that we are sorry for our sins is mere hypocrisy, unless we show that we are really sorry for them, by giving them up. Doing is the very life of repentance. Tell us not merely what a man says in religion. Tell us rather what he does.”
