## **GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1) Read 1 Samuel 20:1-22:5. Why did David hide in a cave? What was going on? 2) Read *Psalm 142; Psalm 57.* David wrote these two Psalms while he was in a cave. How have you felt like being in a cave this past year in dealing with COVID-19? 3) Read *Psalm 142:1-2.* David cried out to the LORD. While isolated in a cave he took the time to lament. How have you lamented this past year? 4) Read *Psalm 142:3-4*. David was overwhelmed and isolated. How have you been overwhelmed this year? How have you experienced isolation? Read Psalm 142:5-7; Psalm 16:5; 73:26; 119:57. David turned to the Lord, and he described God as his portion. What did he mean by this? 6) What good things have come out of this pandemic? What have you learned through this season? FOR YOUR FAMILY 1) Memorize Psalm 57:1- "Have mercy on me, O God, have mercy on me, for in You my soul takes refuge. I will take refuge in the shadow of your wings until the disaster has passed." 2) Read *Psalm 142:1-4.* Discuss with your family why David was hiding in a cave. Talk about what
