## Health Screening Guidelines\*

*Please check the appropriate answers.*

### Pre-Camp Arrival Screening

- Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of *Covid-19* in the past 14 days? \_\_\_Yes \_\_\_No  
Are you experiencing a cough, shortness of breath or sore throat? \_\_\_Yes \_\_\_No  
Have you had a fever of over 100.4 degrees within the last 48 hours? \_\_\_Yes \_\_\_No  
Have you currently lost your senses of taste and smell? \_\_\_Yes \_\_\_No  
Have you experienced vomiting within the last 24 hours? \_\_\_Yes \_\_\_No

Prior to departing to Eagle Rock, campers' temperatures will be taken by designated group leader with a "No Touch" thermometer. Normal temperatures should not exceed 100.4.

Any camper or leader who answers "yes" to any of the above screening questions will be ineligible to come to Eagle Rock. Please stay home for your sake and for others.

### Health Screening at Eagle Rock

- Temperatures will be taken daily by visiting group leaders.
- Any camper that exhibits a fever above 100.4 or any other *COVID* symptoms listed above will be placed in isolation for monitoring. Eagle Rock reserves the right to require additional local professional medical evaluation for visiting campers.
- Since campers are not permitted to remain on campus with these continuing symptoms, parents/guardians shall agree to make arrangements for their child's timely return home if asked.
- Visiting group leaders shall keep parents informed.
