In October we joined with a new partner in Cambodia to launch a station in a village. We were able to provide training to the team of nationals who will soon take over the technical responsibility of the stations.

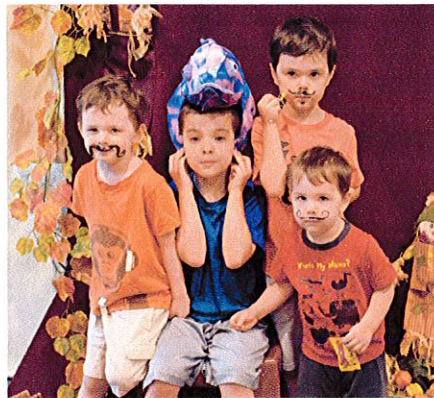
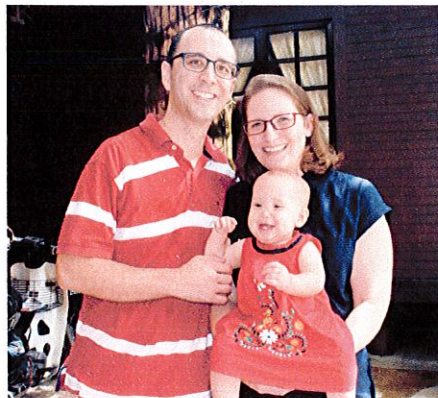
