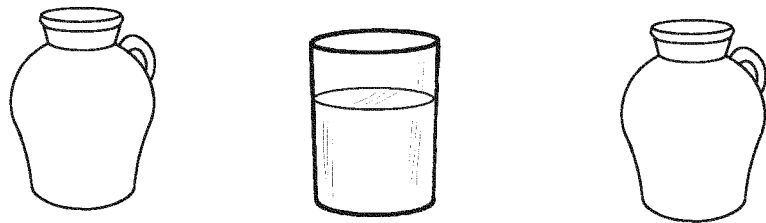
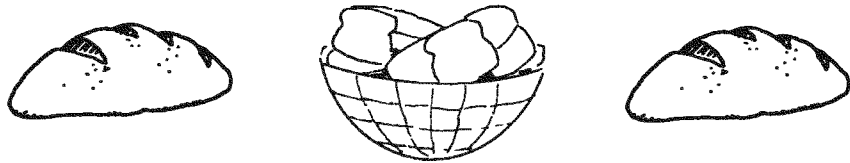


But the man of God answered the king,

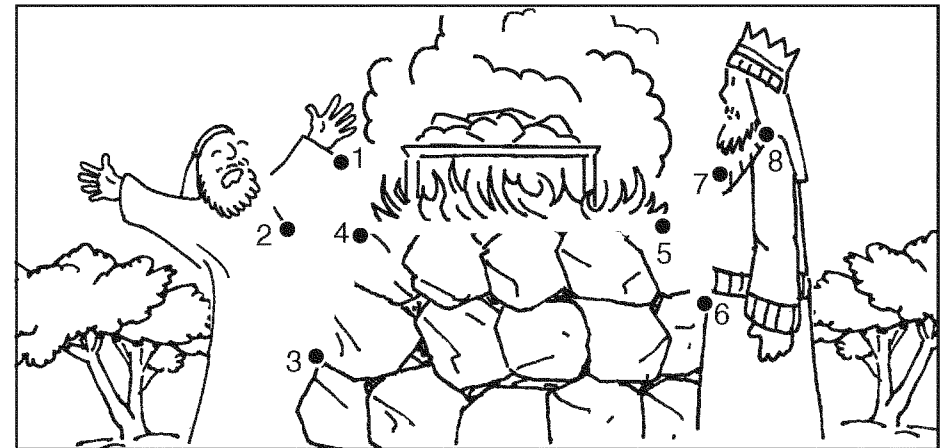

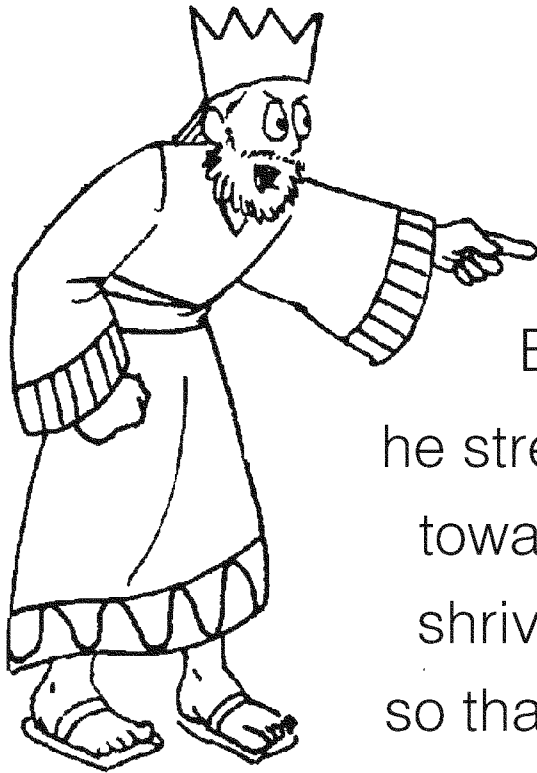
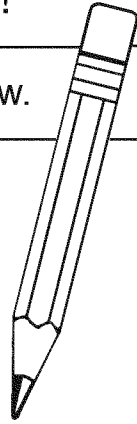


The man gave a warning to those who

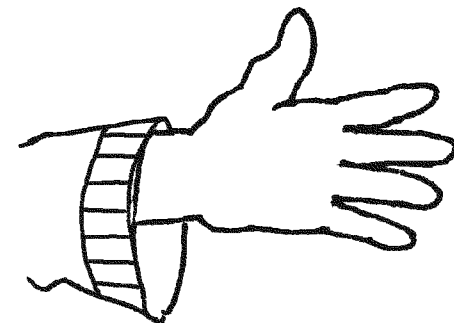
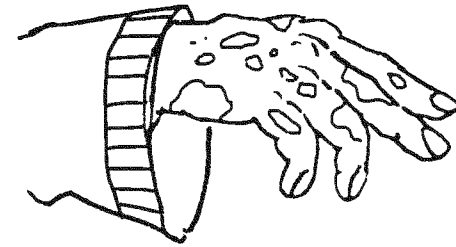


But the hand
