Gospel-Driven Worship and Missions

- D. What are some strategies that you can use to engage people in spiritual conversations?

III. Missions Exists Because Worship Does Not – Read Romans 10:1-4, 14-17

- A. Who is Paul talking about in vv.1-4? How does he describe them?
- B. What is Paul's logic in vv.14-15? How would you describe it in your own works?
- C. Combining vv.1-4 and vv.14-15, what two things are essential for a person's salvation (v.17)?
- D. What needs to change in your life for you to be an effective proclaimer of the gospel?
