#### B. Read John 1:1-14

- 1. Who is the Word and what role does He have in creation?
- 2. How does creation point forward to our salvation in Christ (2 Corinthians 4:5-6)?

#### III. The Gospel in the Old Testament – Prophetic Statements

- A. Read Isaiah 52:13-53:12
  - 1. What descriptions of the Suffering Servant point forward to the Lord Jesus Christ?
  - 2. In what ways is the Servant described as being a substitute for our sins (Isaiah 53:4-6)?
  - 3. What details and accomplishments are given about the Servant's death (Isaiah 53:7-12)?

#### B. Read Acts 8:25-40

- 1. What was the Ethiopian eunuch reading when Philip joined his chariot?
- 2. How does Philip respond to the eunuch's question about Isaiah?

### IV. The Gospel in the Old Testament – Application

- A. How would you like to grow in understanding that all of scripture is about Jesus?
- B. What areas of your life would you like to see growth in being more about Jesus?
