# Jesus Is On The Move

Proclamation Life Groups; Week of Sunday, December 2, 2018; Steve Thiel

Sermon Theme – Jesus Christ, the one true King, is on the move, plundering the devil's kingdom through the faithful preaching of the gospel; which is the power of God to set captives free, deliver them from the domain of darkness and make them sons and daughters of the Kingdom of God!

#### I. Dominating the Devil's Domain – Read Mark 3:7-12

- A. Why were the great crowds coming to Jesus? What do you think they were specifically after?
- B. Whenever the unclean spirits see Jesus, they fall down and cry out, "You are the Son of God." What is the significance of Jesus' decision and ability to silence the demons?
- C. In what area of your life do you joyfully acknowledge Jesus' identity as the Son of God, but not willingly submit to His authority? What plan could you put in place to grow in that area?

### II. Expanding the Kingdom's Borders – Read Mark 3:13-19

- A. What stands out to you in the calling of the 12 disciples? Why do you think He calls only 12?
- B. How is their commissioning (vv.14-15) consistent with ours as followers of Christ?

### III. Plundering the Devil's Possessions – Read Mark 3:20-30

- A. What are the different ways in which Jesus' family and the religious leaders show themselves to be outsiders instead of insiders? What are some of the accusations they make against Jesus?
- B. How does (v.27) help us understand that Jesus is in the process of binding Satan? What do you think it means to bind Satan and plunder his possessions? How is Revelation 20:1-3 helpful?
- C. How would you like to grow in sharing the gospel in order to plunder more people from the enemy's kingdom? What are a few steps you could make to move forward in evangelism?

## IV. Delivering the Kingdom's Children – Read Mark 3:31-35

- A. How would you describe the difference between the physical family and the spiritual family? How is Jesus' teaching in Matthew 10:34-39 helpful in prioritizing Jesus over relationships?
- B. In what areas would you like to move from "good intensions" to actually doing the will of God?
- C. King Jesus is moving forward and the Kingdom of God is advancing? What are some of the evidences in your life and in the life of the church that this is taking place?
