The Bible

We value the Bible because it's God's inspired and inerrant Word, declaring the gospel of Jesus Christ from Genesis to Revelation (2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:21; Luke 24:25-32, 44-47).

I. Read 2 Timothy 3:10-17

- 1. What is the context of this passage and what is Paul's encouragement to Timothy?
- 2. List all the things that you learn about the bible from verses 16-17?
- 3. How does this passage clarify your thinking about the relevancy of the bible for every day life?

II. Read 2 Peter 1:19-21

- 1. What picture is given in verse 19 and how is it helpful as you think about the bible?
- 2. How do verses 20 and 21 help us understand the process in which the bible was written?
- 3. How does passage increase your confidence in the Word of God?

III. Read Luke 24:13-49

- 1. What stands out to you with regard to the Old Testament being about Jesus Christ?
- 2. How does Jesus make it clear that the scriptures are centrally about the gospel?
- 3. What other passages are helpful in confirming that the entire bible, from Genesis to Revelation, is declaring the good news about Jesus Christ and His death, burial, and resurrection?
- 4. How does passage influence or transform the way you read your bible?

IV. Application Questions

- 1. How do these passages challenge your thinking about the bible?
- 2. How does this study influence the priority that you place on the scriptures?
- 3. What changes can and should you make with regard to sharing the gospel with others?
