The Gospel

II. The only remedy for our sin problem - SAVIOR

- 1. According to Matthew 1:21, why did God (Jesus) become a man?
- 2. How does Jesus help us with our sin problem (2 Corinthians 5:21)?
- 3. According to Romans 5:8, what is God's motivation for sending Jesus?
- 4. How must we respond to be saved (Ephesians 2:8-10)?

III. The solution is truly effective – SAVING FAITH

- 1. According to Jesus, how do you know that someone's come to faith (Matthew 7:15-23)?
- 2. According to Paul, how do you know that someone's come to faith (Galatians 5:16-24)?
- 3. According to Peter, how do you know that someone's come to faith (2 Peter 1:1-11)?
- 4. According to John, how do you know that someone's come to faith (1 John 2:3-6)?

- 2. How does Romans 1:16 and 10:14-17 influence what we do as a church?
- 3. In what areas do you need to grow in regard to gospel clarity?
