### **Fall 2023 Subject Overview**

The following covers an overview of the subjects planned for this semester. These subjects will not be discussed or taught in depth. We will focus on the basics, which gives each family freedom to explore more at home if desired! This is not meant to be a curriculum, but instead an added resource and an opportunity to build community. We want to add value to each family’s homeschool experience, not add work!

#### **Science:**

- Learn about when God made animals and their habitats (weeks 1-5)
- Basics about the layers of the earth, volcanoes, atmosphere and clouds (weeks 6-10)

#### **Art:**

- Basics about 12 new artists and the time period they lived
- Projects will include water colors, clay, and tempera paints

★Please bring a painting smock or old shirt for art every week if you do not want paint on clothes. All paint should be washable!

#### **Bonus subjects:**

- Sign language (weeks 1-2)
- All about birds (week 3)
- Basics about story telling (week 4)
- Visit from a zoo keeper (week 5)
- Drama classes (week 6-10)
