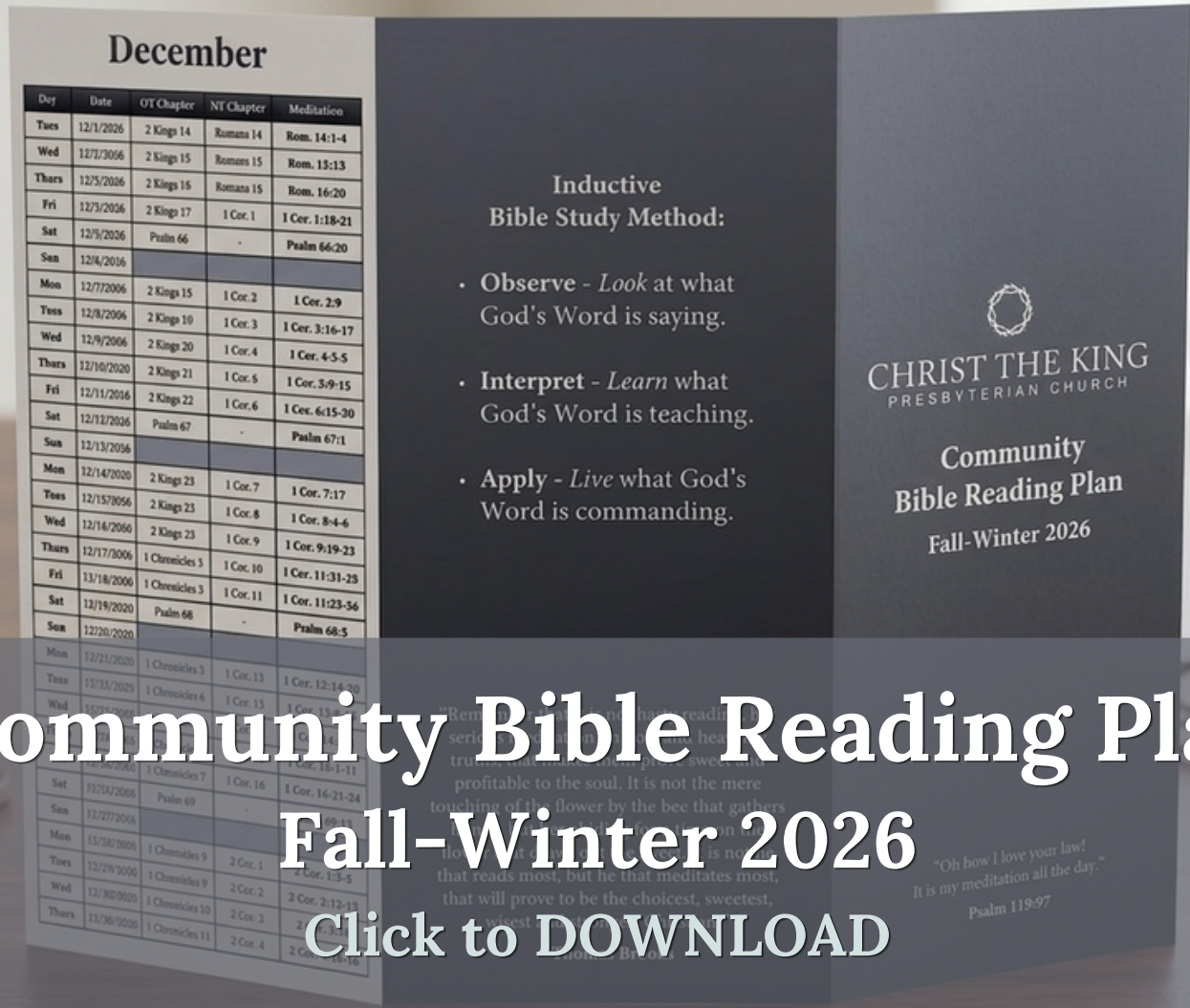

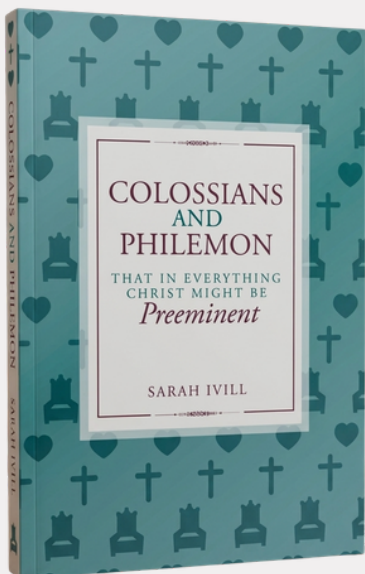

Like the church at Colossae, we often are presented with false teachings that challenge Christ's supremacy and sufficiency, trying to deceive us into thinking wisdom and knowledge can be found apart from Christ. That's simply not true. Jesus is enough.

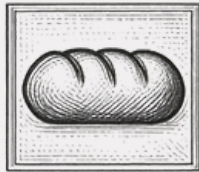

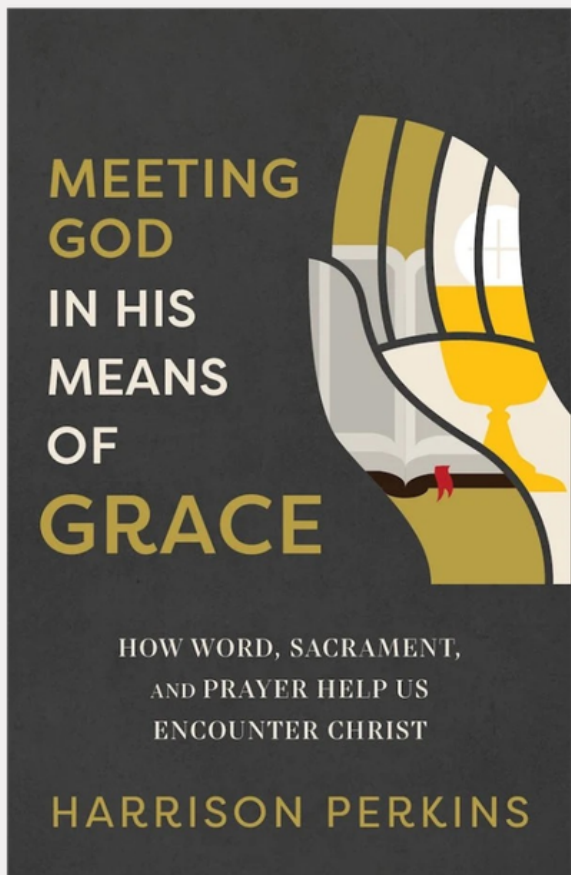
