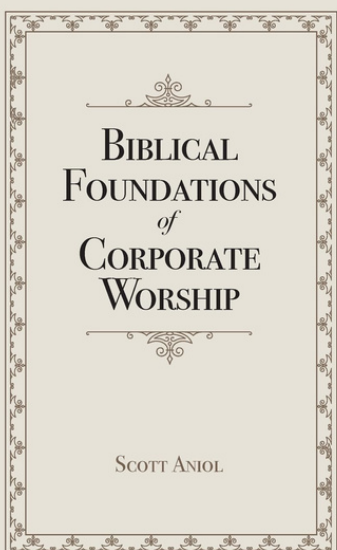

Change in Online Giving Provider

The Session of Christ the King (CTK) wishes to thank all our generous donors who by their tithes and offerings allow CTK to continue ministering the gospel in Port St Lucie.

CTK has provided an option for online giving for some time from our website, utilizing PayPal. You may not be aware that even for non-credit/debit card giving, PayPal charges fees ranging from 2% to over 4% **for every** donation. The amount that CTK actually receives from your offerings is reduced by these fees. In 2024 and 2025, those fees were about \$800 each year, which is money from your offerings that CTK never sees and cannot be used for the ministries of the church.

In order to be the best stewards possible of our members' funds, the Session is changing the online giving provider that will be linked to on our website. The PCA Foundation (PCAF) is an Agency of the PCA (www.pcafoundation.com). Its Mission is to enable Christians to give more effectively to advance the Kingdom of Jesus Christ. One of the many services they provide to PCA Churches and Donors is online giving. With the arrangement CTK will have with the PCAF, there will be no fees deducted from your offerings, providing an estimated additional \$800/year toward the Church's ministries. Both one-time and recurring donations can be set up, from bank accounts or credit/debit cards. (Credit/Debit Card donations will incur a fee from the credit card company, not PCAF). An account is not required with the PCAF for giving, but is available, and provides additional benefits such as donation history, the ability to initiate new donations, update address information, and ability to edit existing recurring donations. The PCAF giving page for CTK can be accessed by going to our website (www.christthekingpsl.com) and choosing Give on the menu.

The Session encourages everyone currently giving through PayPal to migrate to the new provider, as that will allow 100% of your offerings (non-credit/debit) to flow to CTK. However, this is not mandatory. Existing recurring donations set up in PayPal, or new one-time donations through PayPal, will continue to flow to CTK, albeit minus the PayPal fees. However, going forward our website Give option will now link to the new CTK page at PCAF.

NOTE: Offerings made via this method are to the PCAF, who weekly transfers all accumulated donations to CTK. CTK will be provided a list of all contributions and contributors. End of year tax statements for contributions made will come from the PCA Foundation. This also will save our Treasurer a lot of year-end efforts as this currently has to be done manually with PayPal.
