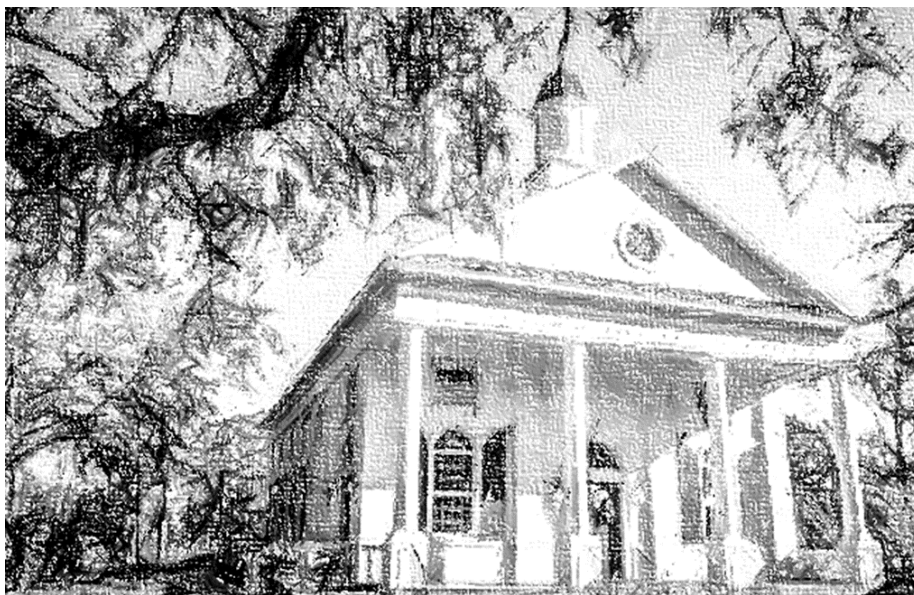

## SILENT CONFESSION OF SIN

### CORPORATE CONFESSION OF SIN

*Almighty God, Creator of heaven and earth, and Redeemer of your people, we bow in humble confession of our sins. You alone know how often we have offended you and injured others. All our righteousness is as filthy rags; we all fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away; there is none among us who calls upon your name as we should, nor any that stirs himself to take hold of you. Be merciful to us, O Lord. Wash us thoroughly from our iniquities and cleanse us from our sins. Turn us from our wayward paths. Search and try our ways, and draw us unto you, and let your lovingkindness and your truth continually preserve us, to the glory of Christ Jesus our Lord, through whom we come to you, and for whose sake we would forsake our sins and walk in righteousness. It's in Jesus' name we pray. Amen.*

### ASSURANCE OF PARDON

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

## AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Q. 1. What is your only comfort in life and death?

*A. That I am not my own, but belong with body and soul, both in life and in death, to my faithful Savior Jesus Christ. He has fully paid for all my sins with His precious blood and has set me free from all the power of the devil. He also preserves me in such a way that without the will of my heavenly Father, not a hair can fall from my head; indeed, all things must work together for my salvation. Therefore, by His Holy Spirit He also assures me of eternal life and makes me heartily willing and ready from now on to live for Him.*

Q. 2. What do you need to know in order to live and die in the joy of this comfort?

*A. First, how great my sins and misery are; second, how I am delivered from all my sins and misery; third, how I am to be thankful to God for such deliverance.*
