

CORPORATE CONFESSION OF SIN

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Romans 5:20-21

Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more, so that, as sin reigned in death, grace also might reign through righteousness leading to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

- Q. 79. Which is the tenth commandment?
 - A. The tenth commandment is, You shall not covet your neighbor's house, you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his male servant, nor his female servant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that is your neighbor's.
- Q. 80. What is required in the tenth commandment?
 - A. The tenth commandment requires full contentment with our own condition, with a right and charitable frame of spirit toward our neighbor, and all that is his.
- Q. 81. What is forbidden in the tenth commandment?
 - A. The tenth commandment forbids all discontentment with our own estate, envying or grieving at the good of our neighbor, and all inordinate motions and affections to anything that is his.
