Series: *Generations—It Shall Be Told* (Week 2)

Scripture: 2 Timothy 1:15-2:13

Summary: Due to weather we had to cancel services this past Sunday. However, we still would like to provide you with some questions for discussion to keep this critical series at the forefront of everyone's mind. Below you will find some general questions to help you discuss next Sunday's Scripture passage, as well as process this important series further.

### Questions for Discussion:

1. As you have had more time to process the first week's sermon and the video premiere of *Generations*, how has it affected the way you understand what it means to live the Christian life and as a disciple of Jesus?
2. Pastor Mike talked about the commitment cards as "instruments of accountability and worship." What does that mean for you? How would you improve or restate the importance and significance of something like a commitment card?
3. What would you say is still lingering in your mind from week one's sermon called *Guard the Good Deposit*? Is it a verse, a quote, a word, or a saying? Explain.
4. Have someone read the entire passage for next Sunday's sermon carefully and out loud (2 Timothy 1:15-2:13). Based on the title of next Sunday's sermon ("Faithful Soldiers"), have everyone share all the ways that seem to describe or model a faithful soldier of Christ Jesus. It might be helpful to take each section one at a time.
  - a. Section one: ch. 1, verses 15-18
  - b. Section two: ch. 2, verses 1-7
  - c. Section three: ch. 4, verses 8-13
5. How often do you think about the Christian life as a soldier? How does the idea of a soldier of Christ shape the way you think about your own life as a disciple? What would change? How you think, feel, or live?

**PRAYER:** Take some time to pray specifically for God to work through this Generations series. Give people time to pray things that came up in the Scripture discussion as well.
