EMPHASIS FOR THE MONTH: Laying a Foundation & Building Relational Capital

Through vivid illustrations and personal vulnerability, Pastor Mike acknowledges the real financial struggles facing us in North Jersey while pointing to Jesus's ultimate sacrifice as the model for fearless generosity. He weaves together biblical truth with practical wisdom, emphasizing that generosity isn't about rigid rules like 10% tithing, but about responding to God's extravagant grace. The sermon culminates in a powerful call to action: rather than making impulsive decisions, we are encouraged to pray for courage and wisdom to develop sustainable generous living that demonstrates trust in God as our ultimate provider. The sermon closes with a reflection on eternal perspective and left us contemplating not just our giving habits, but our entire approach to stewardship in light of eternity.

QUESTION #1: Pastor Mike stated that, "the true mark of generosity is a sense of life being lost." What does this mean, and how does it differ from common views of generosity? How do you feel about this statement and do you agree or disagree, and why?

QUESTION #2: How does the story of the widow's offering challenge or affirm your current understanding of giving and generosity?

QUESTION #3: What fears do you have when it comes to giving or being generous and how do these fears impact your actions?

QUESTION #4: How does the Gospel's portrayal of Jesus' ultimate sacrifice on the cross for you make you feel about the concept of generosity?

PRAY TOGETHER: Spend time taking *and recording* prayer requests and then pray together as a group (*I* strongly encourage you to send out the prayer requests weekly to your group to keep everyone informed and in the loop on how to pray for one another throughout the week. This also makes it easier to check-in with people who have shared requests to see how the Lord has been working in their lives).
