Study Questions

"The Faithful Rock" Pt 2 Deuteronomy 32:1-4

- 1) **READ** Deuteronomy 32:1-4 and **Leviticus 1:3**. What condition did the burnt offering have to be in to present it as a sacrifice to the Lord according to Leviticus 1:3? Compare the following verses and observe if that is also true of those sacrifices: Exodus 12:15; Leviticus 14:10; Numbers 29:17. What specifically does that answer mean for the sacrifice (Leviticus 22:21-25)?
- 2) Leviticus 1:3 says, "... He shall bring it to the entrance of the tent of meeting, that he may be accepted before the Lord." Could there have been certain conditions inherent in the animal that would prevent it from being acceptable to the Lord? All animal sacrifices were made to whom and on whose behalf? What is the connection between the sacrifice of animals from the Old Testament and the sacrifice of Christ in the New Testament? READ Hebrews 9:14.
- 3) Deuteronomy 32:4 tells us that the Lord's work is perfect. The word used from "perfect" is the same word used for "without blemish." What type of "work" does the Lord do? Is it possible to then say the work you stated is God's perfect work and without blemish? Would you say the Lord's work in you is perfect? Why or why not? **READ** Philippians 2:15. What struggle do you have with that passage if any?
- 4) Our passage also informs us that God is faithful? How has the Lord been faithful to you? Describe the faithfulness of a friend and how does this compare with the faithfulness of God? Psalm 118 speaks of the steadfast love of the Lord which has also been translated as "faithful love," "lovingkindness," "mercy," "and "loyal love." Can you think of any other

- words to describe the faithfulness of the Lord? Use five (5) tones/notes and create a quick melody to the Lord using your word(s) and the lyrics.
- **5) READ** Deuteronomy 32:2. What are the benefits to obedient hearers of the Words of God?
- 6) **READ** 1 Corinthians 10:1-4. Does this passage tell us that Christ was also present with the Israelites as they travelled through the wilderness? **READ**John 8:58. What does Jesus Christ say about His existence? Will Jesus be faithful to you in the future? What comfort does that bring you?
