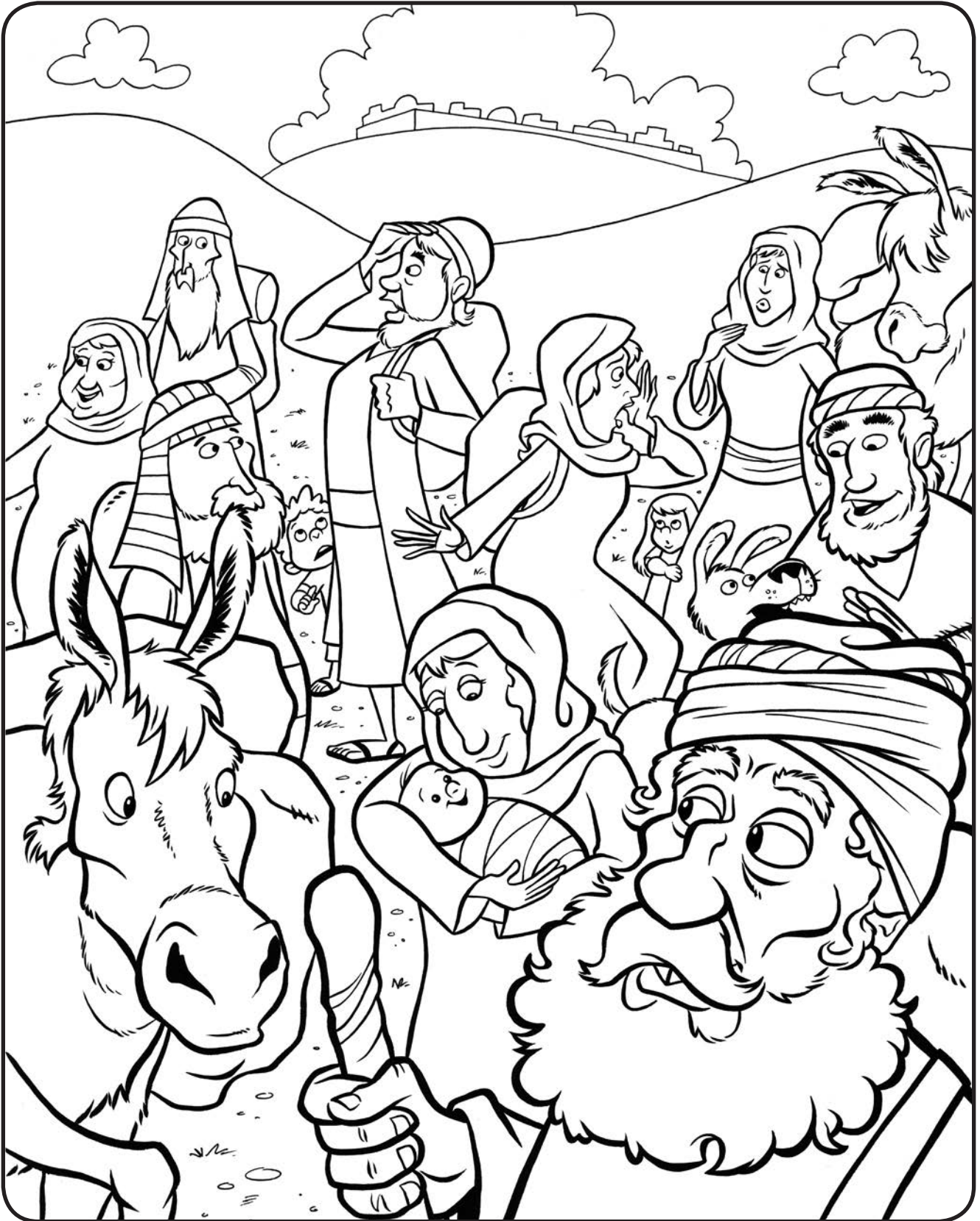

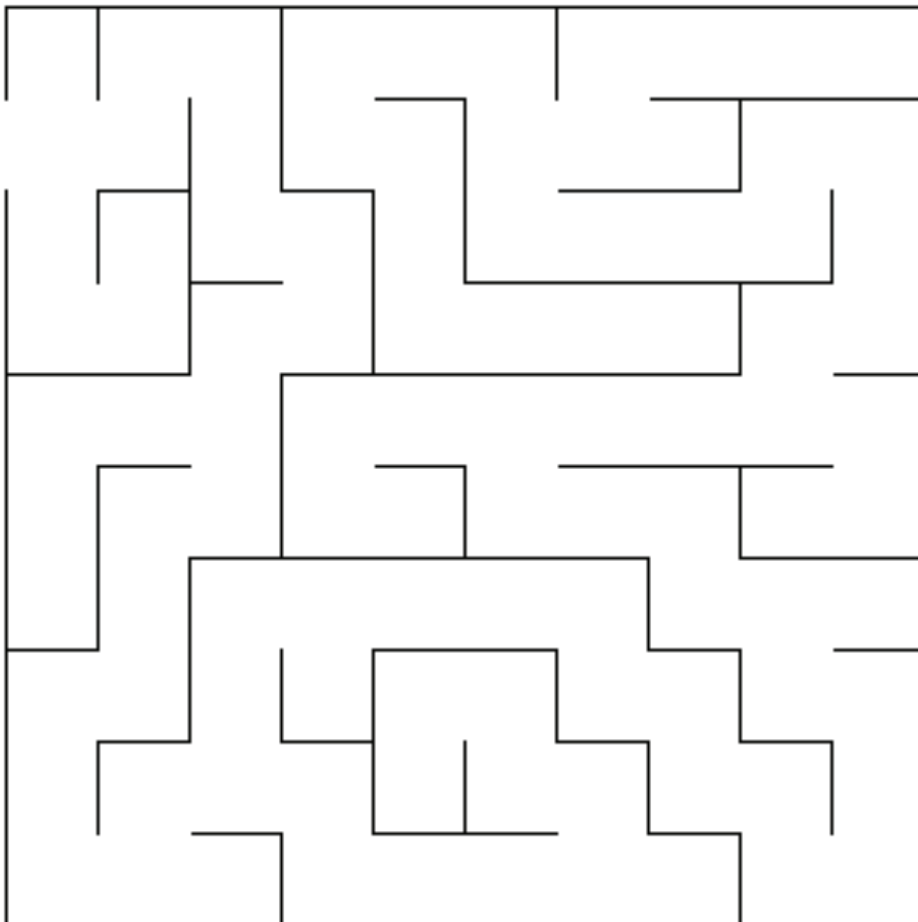
Jesus' favor with God and man shows He is the Savior.
