Jonah did not obey God at first. Connect the dots to see what God used to bring Jonah to repentance.



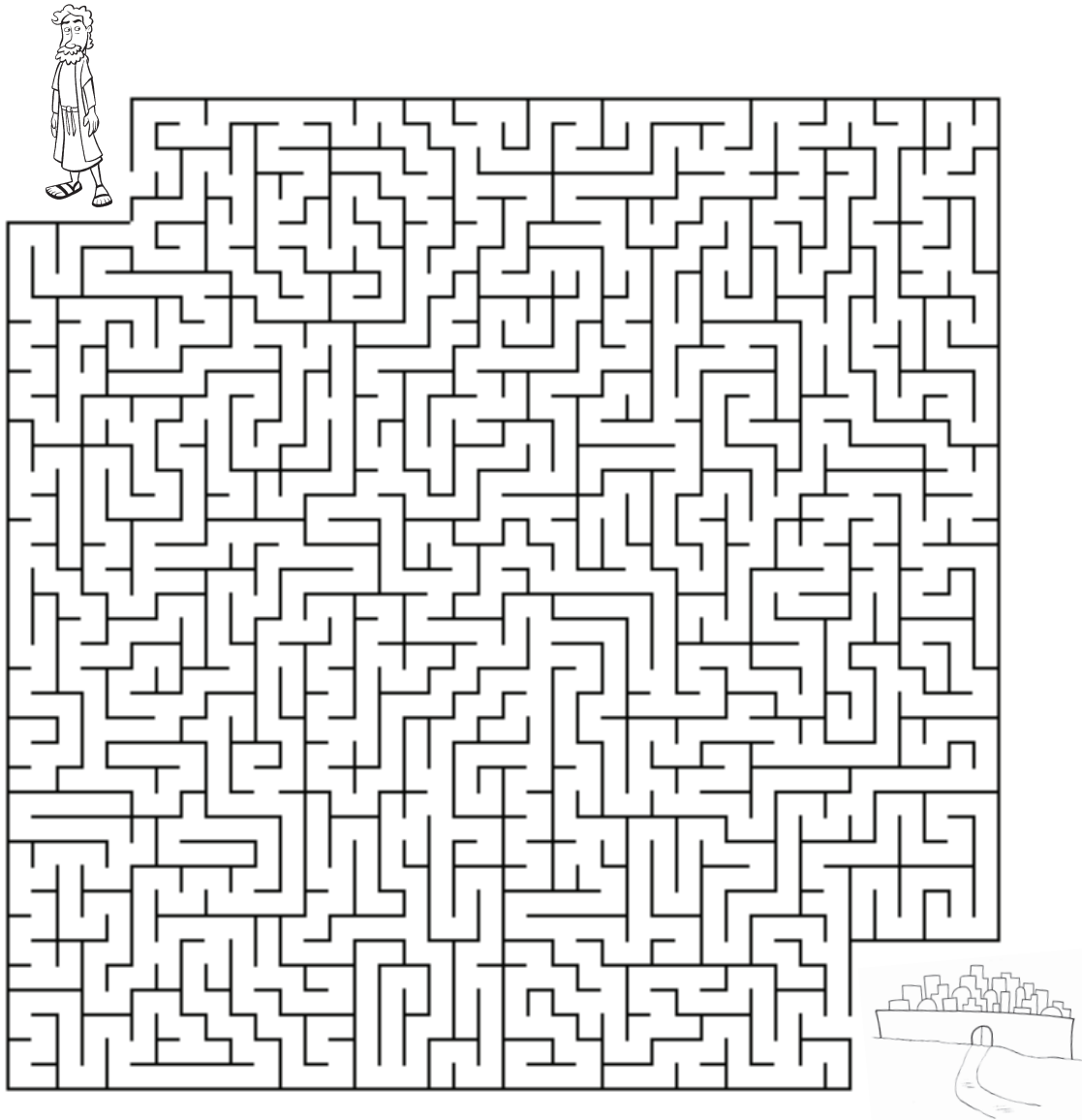
