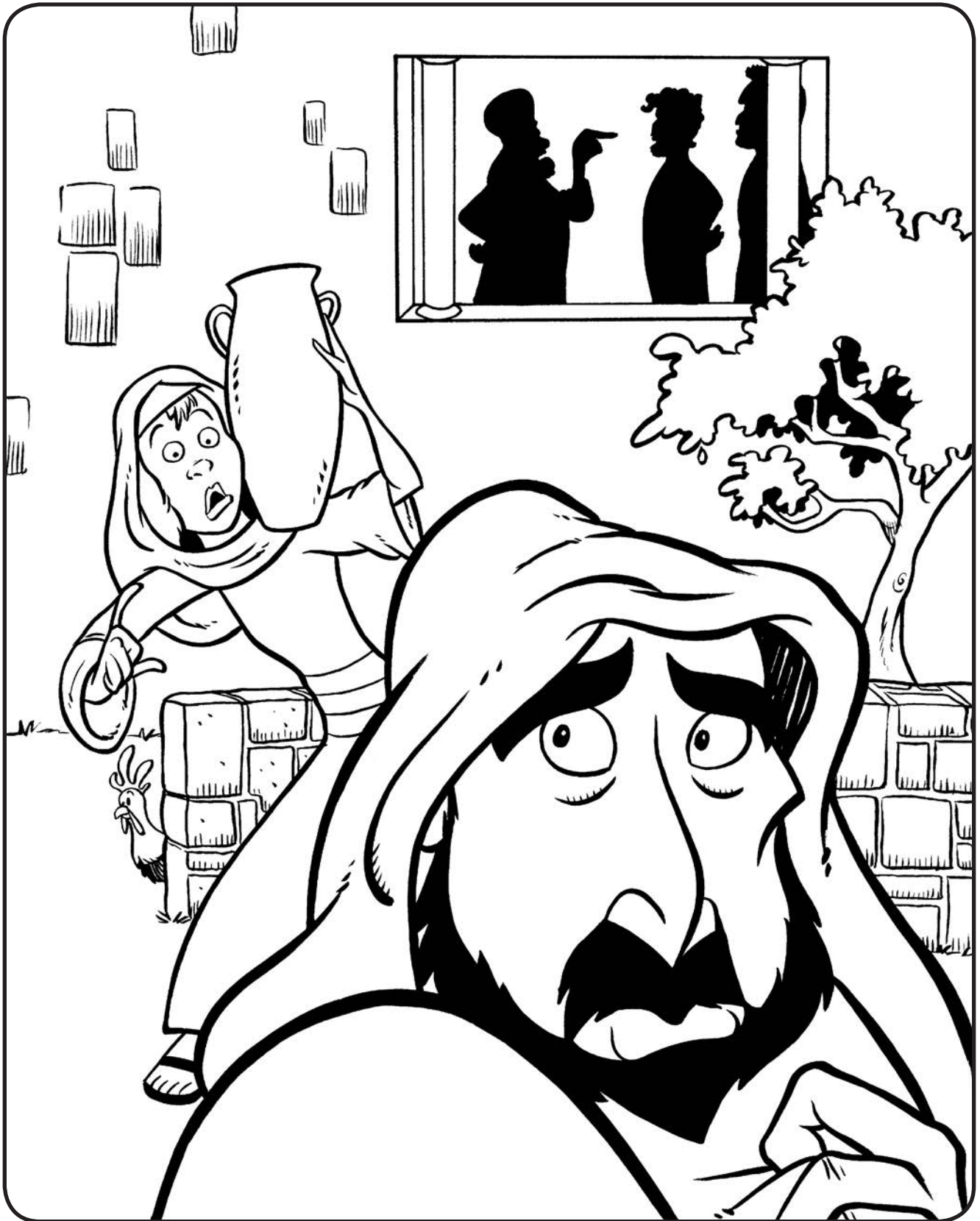

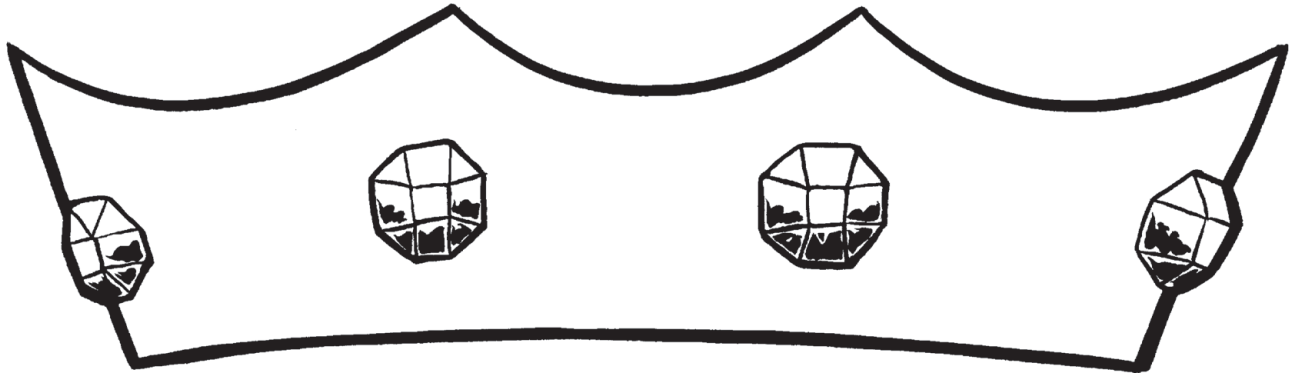

## Crowns

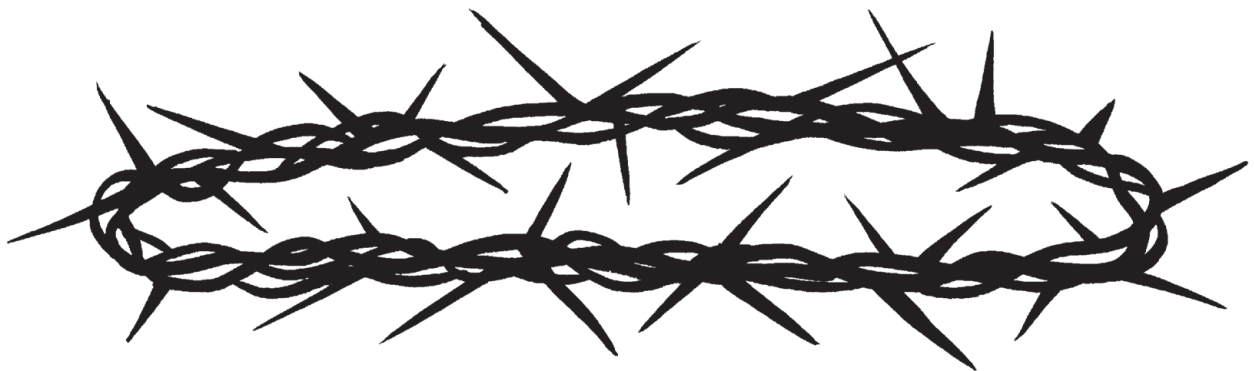
