

Regathering Guidelines for CBC at Home

Home Gathering Changes

- Our state and county are requiring a limited capacity for either 25% of our building or 100 people, whichever is lower. For us, that means the host home will need to assess how many people can attend that would provide adequate social distancing for everyone, whether it is inside or outside.
- The host homes should confirm those that are coming to not exceed assessed capacity.

How the host homes should prepare

Required

- Configure the meeting space to have adequate social distancing. (When in doubt see other CDC recommendations).
- Disinfecting public surfaces, doorknobs and handles, bathrooms, etc. before and after the meeting.
- Printing this document and putting it in a visible place as a reminder for social distancing requirements.
- Provide soap and sanitizer for attendees.

Recommended

- If meeting inside keep as many doors and windows open to provide maximum airflow when weather permits it.
- Try to not pass out any materials or share content amongst each other.
- The CDC recommends wearing face masks, but since it's not required, we recommend host homes clearly communicate face mask expectations ahead of time (if they have any expectations).
- Consider not providing drinks, food, or refreshments.

How the attendees can prepare

Required

- Refrain from coming if you are exhibiting any symptoms, are in contact with someone who is sick, or are considered high risk.
- Please be mindful of social distancing norms: adequate distance apart, avoid touching, avoid sharing/passing items, etc.

Recommended

- The CDC recommends wearing face masks, but since it's not required we leave the decision up to each attendee. However, please check with your host home for expectations. (Please be patient with one another's preferences).
- If you have children, please keep them with you and under your supervision. Bring things to keep your kids busy during the meeting.
