

<sup>7</sup>Remember not the sins of my youth or my transgressions; according to your steadfast love remember me, for the sake of your goodness, O LORD!


## \*Good and upright is the LORD; therefore he instructs sinners in the way.



## Lord's Prayer


Our Father who art in heaven,

forever and ever. Amen.






## Collect of the Day: Advent 1
