

They specialize in offering comprehensive pre-abortion consultations so that women can make a confident, fully informed decision while encouraging their patients to choose life for their unborn child.

### Ministry Overview

For 130 years, our Christian ministry has compassionately served men, women, and children without a home and with nowhere else to turn. Thanks to the generosity of our community, we are able to help our guests in need with safe emergency shelter, wholesome meals, clothing, physical and mental wellness care, job- and life-skills training, relationship counseling, and caring Christian case management.

Sharing the love of God and the good news of the Gospel of Jesus Christ is the heart of our ministry. Though our methods are effective for the 21st century, we have held true to our 1892 mission: To aid the poor and needy; to reform the erring; to help those that are out of the way; to feed the hungry; to shelter the homeless; to preach the Gospel; and to rescue the perishing.

The Union Mission Ministries also include the Union Mission Thrift Store, which helps benefit and support our shelters; Hope Haven, our rural Virginia Beach campus that operates a Christian children's home, an overnight summer camp, and related year-round ministries; and Reaching Romania, an outreach for orphans, widows, and poor citizens in the European Union's most poverty-ridden country.

### Ministry Overview

Michael and Julie work at a Bible translation society where Michael manages the Scripture Engagement Department, which exists to equip national saints to edify their own churches through the translated word of God. This includes training nationals to read, interpret, and apply Scripture, training national leaders, and working with churches to improve the usability of their Bible translations.

### Ministry Requests:

## Ministry Overview

Wesley teaches the New Testament at Forman Christian College. He is primarily responsible for teaching Greek and exegesis courses as part of a master's in biblical studies.

## Ministry Requests:

- Center for Biblical and Theological Research – construction on the center has been finished and we are currently using the facilities! Please pray for the Christian Studies faculty who are planning the events for pastors and church leaders this year. We are asking that God would give us wisdom to organize lectures and seminars that would contribute to the growth of the church in Pakistan, and that the Center itself would be a catalyst for more effective outreach within the Christian community.
- Mentorship and Coaching – I am currently supervising 3 students who are working on their M.Phil. theses: Anil, Imran, and Ejaz. All three have been progressing slowly because of family and ministry responsibilities, so please pray that they will have skill to manage their time well and that they will be efficient in their research and writing. I would also ask special prayer for the 6 M.Phil./New Testament students who began their studies in 2024. The whole group struggled to produce quality work last year, and I felt like the instruction I gave missed where they were at. On the one hand, pray that the students would be diligent and would not grow discouraged; on the other hand, pray that I would be more proficient at helping them develop in their ability to translate and interpret Scripture.
- Discipleship – One of the privileges of teaching master's-level courses is that many of my students are already engaged in extensive ministry within the context of their local churches. Pray that we would have wisdom from the Spirit as we seek to integrate academic study with real-world, day-to-day pastoral responsibilities.

## Personal Requests:

- Spiritual Growth – My default posture towards people is one often characterized by frustration and annoyance when it ought to be characterized by understanding and compassion. ### Trip Overview


