- Sarah is waiting on a new visa and other paperwork to be able to continue her work. Pray for the Lord's hand of guidance in her life.


Needed: Missionary Care Advocates

Missionary Care Advocates help to provide prayer, communication, and care for a Colonial missionary by corresponding with them on the field throughout their time overseas and helping to ease their transition between home and the field by building and nurturing relationships and helping to meet practical needs when they are in our community. Missionary Care Advocates are called to come alongside the mission team at Colonial by being their representative to the church body. Missionary Care Advocates are a vital link in maintaining the relationship between Colonial and its missionaries both while they are on the field and back in the US.
