

Notes for corrections to Murray's Matt 2:1–16 video recording. Corrections are shown **in bold brown** with the incorrect statements **highlighted in bright lime-green**.

Slide 7

Correction 1: The areas we're going to cover start from when Gabriel talks to Zacharias which is Dec 15 of 4 BC, to when Herod attempts to kill the boys which is midnight that starts January 10th of **1 BC**. At 14 min and 41 seconds into the presentation, I incorrectly said, "January 10 of **2** BC."

Correction 2: So His **conception** is on Yom Teruah which is one of seven appointed days in Leviticus chapter 23. At 17 minutes and 14 seconds into the presentation, I incorrectly said: "His **birth** is on Yom Teruah ..."

Correction 3: Again, Gabriel speaking to Zacharias is the first day of the Feast of Dedication, and it's also a **Saturday**. At 20 minutes and 57 seconds into the presentation, I incorrectly said, "and it's also a **Sunday**."

Slide 8

Correction 4: some people give specific dates, like Tertullian who gives it four different ways. He says it was 28 years after the death of Cleopatra and **15** years before the death of Augustus. At 23 minutes and 3 seconds into the presentation, I incorrectly said "and **19** years before the death of Augustus".

Correction 5: And we have in Luke 4 and Luke **13** Jesus' analogies to the duration of His ministry. At 24 minutes and 19 seconds into the presentation, I incorrectly said "And we have in Luke 4 and Luke **12** Jesus' analogies to the duration of His ministry."

Slide 14

Correction 6: But you know, Romans 8:16 **and 17** says as children of God we are co-heirs with Jesus Christ. I should have included vs. 17 but didn't, at 31 minutes and 15 seconds into the presentation, saying, "But you know, Romans **8:16** says as children of God we are co-heirs."

Slide 19

Correction 7: A thousand years **earlier**, there was another conjunction that was almost as bright. Well, it was as bright. At 46 minutes and 48 seconds into the presentation, I incorrectly said, "A thousand years **later**, there was another conjunction that was almost as bright."

Correction 8: What is this? Isaiah **7:14**: behold a virgin ... Instead, at 51 minutes and 36 seconds into the presentation, I said "What is this? Isaiah **11:14**, behold a virgin ..."

Slide 20

Correction 9: It turns out it happened 2 hours and 44 minutes before sunset on September 11th of **3** BC, which is a Wednesday. Instead, at 54 minutes and 14 seconds into the presentation, I incorrectly said, "It turns out it happened at 2 hours and 44 minutes before sunset on September 11th of **1** BC, which is a Wednesday."

Slide 21

Correction 10: This is the most appropriate time. This is the most appropriate day. And the description, Rev **12**, gets it to a tee. Instead, at 56 minutes and 15 seconds into the presentation, I incorrectly said, "And the description, Rev **21**, gets it to a tee."

Slide 26

Correction 11: "in the commonly shared **window of** mid-February of 2 BC to mid-August of **2** BC." Instead, at 1 hour 15 minutes, and 54 seconds into the presentation, I incorrectly said, "in the common shared mid-February of 2 BC to mid-August of **3** BC."

Slide 30

Correction 12: So, this is the layout we saw before of the constellation Virgo. This is, that little black plus mark, is **the location of** the bright morning star, which was only visible that **one morning in 2884 BC**. But it marks the head of the child in the constellation Virgo. Instead, at about 1 hour and 30 minutes into the presentation, I said, "So, this is the layout we saw before of the constellation Virgo. Correction 13: Jupiter is slightly off to the side. You can probably barely make it out. There is a little blue **plus mark** to the **right** of Jupiter and below it. Instead, at 1 hour, 35 minutes, and 50 seconds, I said "Jupiter is slightly off to the side. You can probably barely make it out. There is a little blue **cross** to the **left** of Jupiter and below it."

Slide 34

Correction 14: This is the predecessor to the conjunction that was Christ's birth star. It's not **nearly** as bright **or spectacular** as Christ's birth star. **But it is the most spectacular Jupiter-Venus conjunction before His birth star**. Instead, at about 1 hour and 42 minutes, I incorrectly said: "It's **historically the brightest one ever** when you consider the effects of the moon." I should have said it's historically the most spectacular one before Christ's birth star. Christ's birth star was substantially more spectacular.

Slide 36

Correction 15: So, just for those that want to know, since the Exodus is in 1448 BC, ... 40 years later they cross the Jordan River. The First Sabbatical year started in **1402** BC. The 201st Sabbatical year started in 2 BC. Instead, at about 1 hour and 46 minutes into the presentation, I incorrectly said, "40 years later they cross the Jordan River. First Sabbatical year starts in **1404** BC."

Correction 16: Joseph doesn't miss a lick. He goes down to Egypt. He's got gold, frankincense, and Myrrh. He's got **two days of forewarning**. Instead, at about 1 hour and 47 minutes into the presentation, I said, "He's got two **and one-half** days forewarning."
