His eyes are a flame of fire, and on His head are many diadems... Revelation 19:12



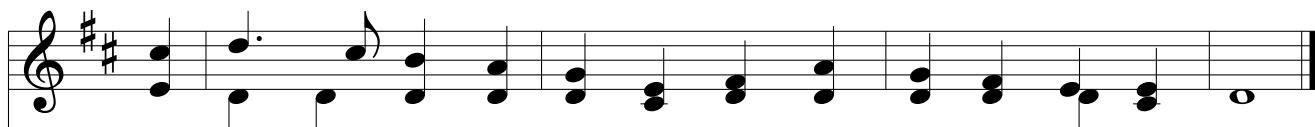
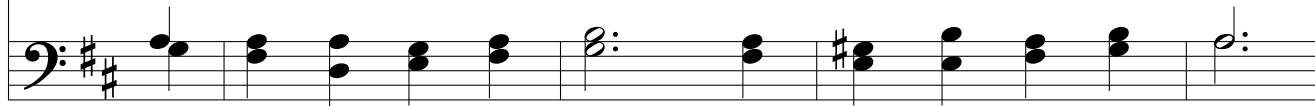
