God's love doth forever flow.

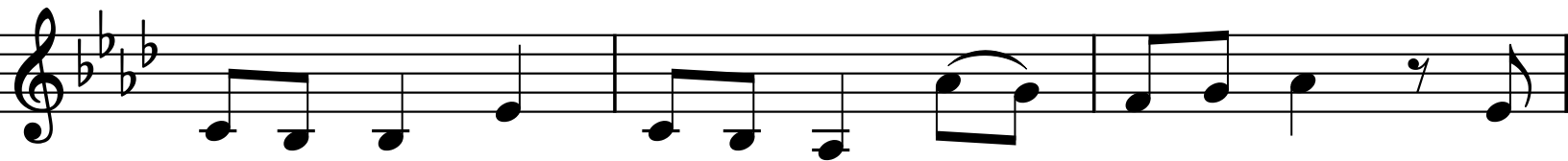
