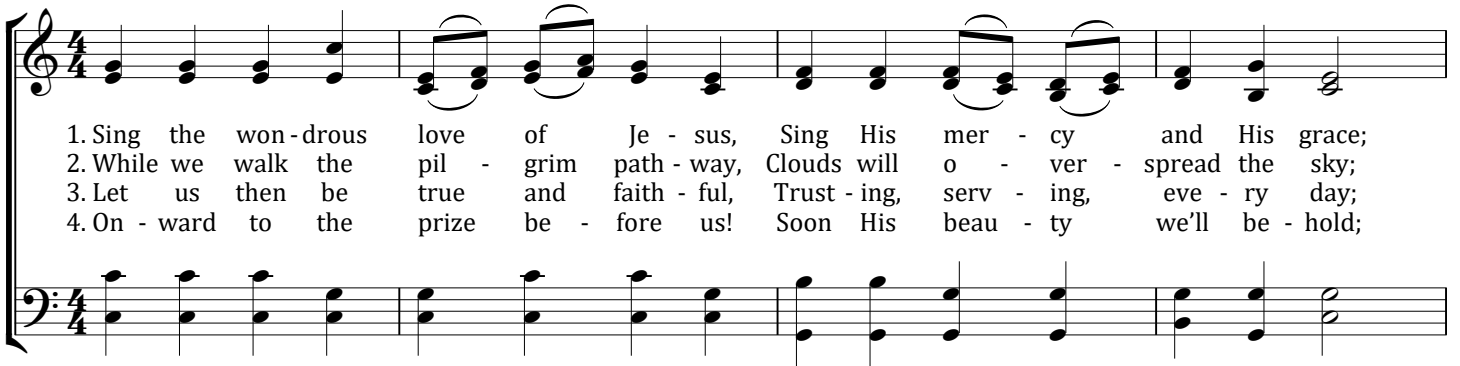

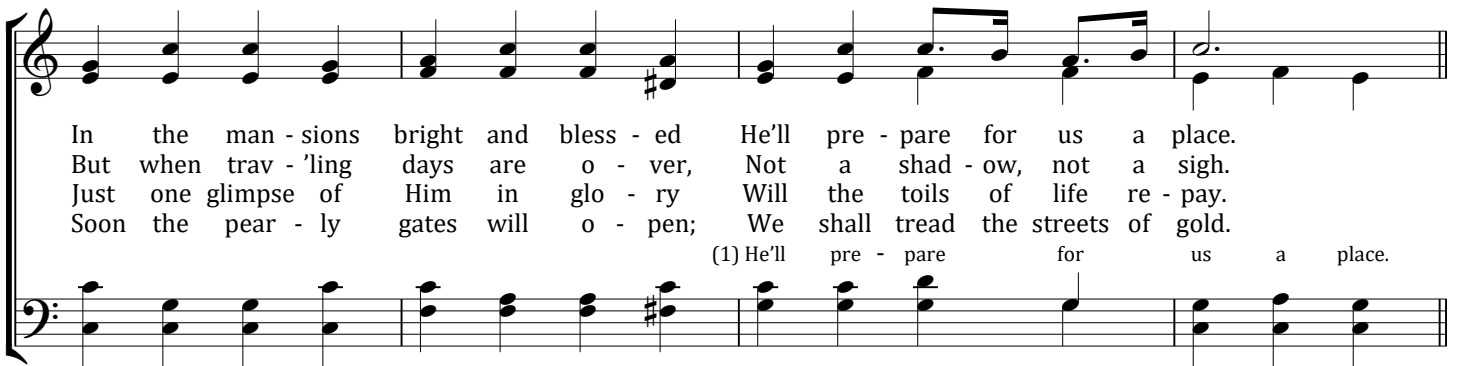

Then we... shall be caught up together... to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. 1 Th. 4:17*

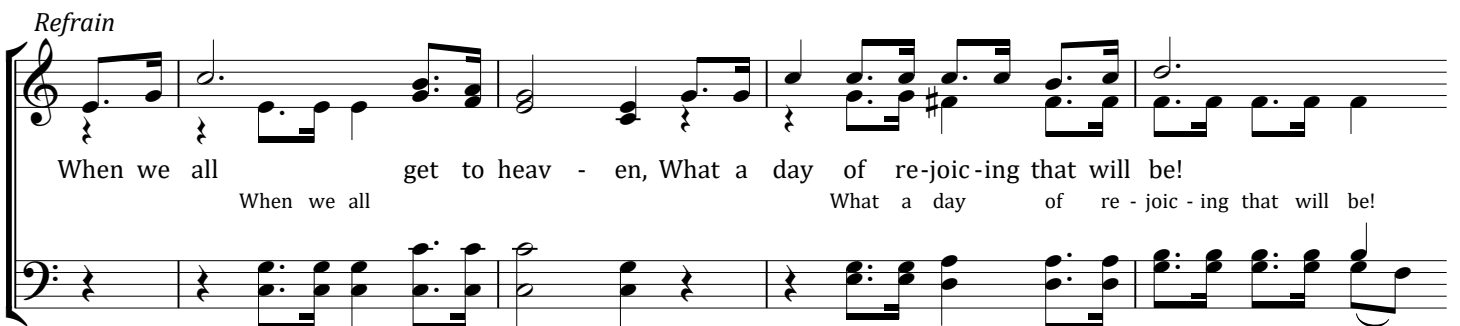

# Nothing But the Blood

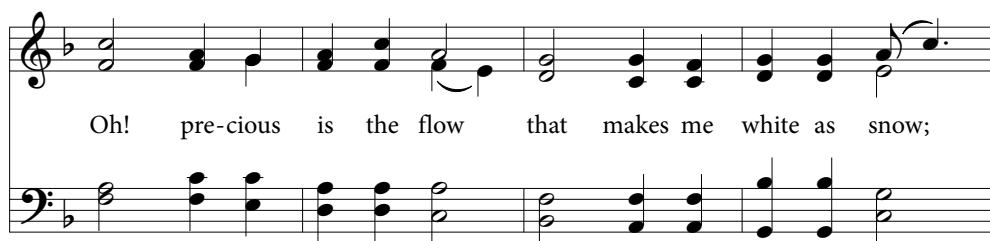

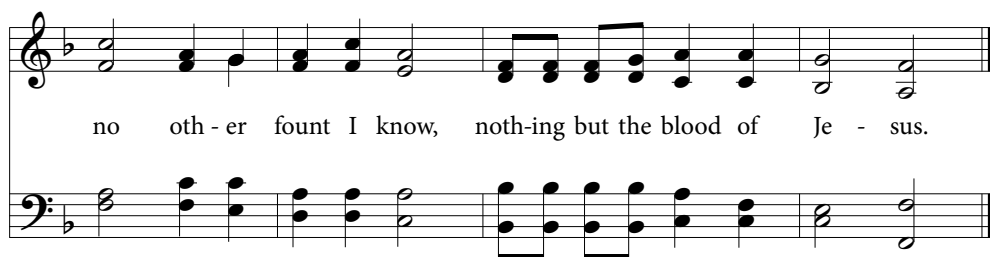
