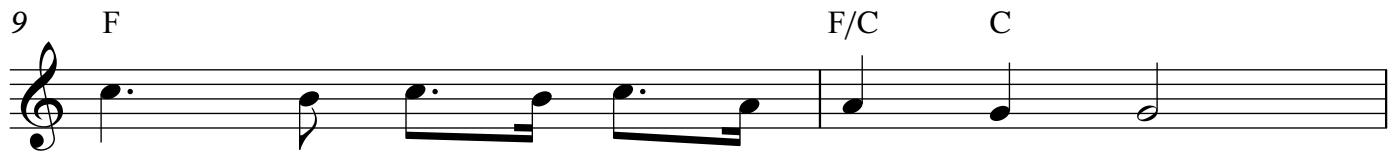
Years I spent in van - i - ty and pride,

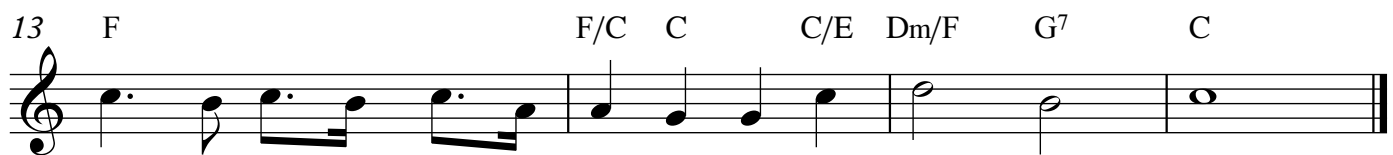
