On the seventh day you shall march around the city seven times, and the priests shall blow the trumpets” (Josh 6:2-5).

God often puts obstacles in the way of His people in order to show His power through their weakness (2 Cor 12:9). He sometimes chooses to act in such extraordinary ways that power is clearly from God and not from us (2 Cor 4:7). God, not human might, would give the city to Israel (6:2).
