
God is a just judge. Sodom and Gomorrah is a real-life illustration of God's justice that God used to teach Abraham what it means to be righteous. By letting Abraham question Him and by rescuing Lot, God showed that justice is full of mercy. But by destroying Sodom and Gomorrah, God showed that justice severely punishes the wicked. Abraham was to teach these lessons to his children so that they would live in righteousness before a just God (Gen 18:17–19).
