CPC COMMUNITY GROUPS

Community Groups at Christ Presbyterian Church exist to promote fellowship, foster a heart of prayer, encounter God's Word together, and reach out to our visitors and neighbors with the love of Christ. Like a chair, this program has four legs:

FELLOWSHIP The first leg of CPC Community Groups is the time spent in intentional fellowship with one another. While this naturally happens at the beginning and end of each gathering, each group is encouraged to set apart time throughout the year for intentional fellowship. Ideas include making every fifth Sunday a social event, group date nights, quarterly outings, and holiday celebrations. This leg intends to grow each group closer together so that genuine bonds of love and trust are formed, and each member is willing to be open and honest with their brothers and sisters in Christ.

PRAYER The second leg of CPC Community Groups is prayer for the Kingdom needs of our church, the greater Georgetown area, and the concerns and cares of its members. To help instill the practice of prayer and the heart for it, a significant portion of each gathering is spent bringing these needs and concerns before the Lord. This kind of prayer is one of the greatest blessings of Christian community and the perfect way to prepare each group to encounter God's Word. This leg intends to redirect our perspective towards the fulfillment of Christ's Kingdom and to raise our sensitivities towards meeting the needs of others.

WORD The third leg of CPC Community Groups is the focused time spent on encountering God's Word. The forms this could take are an interactive discussion of the previous week's sermon, a book study on a particular subject like the Apostle's Creed or busyness, or a section of Holy Scripture itself. This leg intends for each believer to grow in their knowledge of the Christian faith and their understanding of how God has gifted them to serve and bless the church.

OUTREACH The fourth leg of CPC Community Groups is reaching out to those within the church who are new or not fully assimilated into our community life. Rather than being closed to outsiders or "set," community groups should intentionally invite others to join. Each group should consider creative and thoughtful ways to reach out to the broader community as representatives of Christ's Kingdom and our church. This leg intends for each group to grow, mature, and then multiply as the Lord provides spiritually capable leaders.

A note on childcare: The demographics of each group will determine the level of childcare needed. Those with small children will decide as a group what is the best approach. While the ideal is for the adults to have uninterrupted time for prayer and discussion, we recognize that creativity may be needed for some to function in a way that is spiritually beneficial to its members.
