Affirmation of Faith Westminster Shorter Catechism Q&A 101-103

Minister: What do we pray for in the first petition?

Minister: What do we pray for in the second petition?

All: In the second petition, which is, Thy kingdom come," we pray, that Satan's kingdom may be destroyed; and that the kingdom of grace may be advanced, ourselves and others brought into it, and kept in it; and that the kingdom of glory may be hastened.

Minister: What do we pray for in the third petition?

From the Strength of Israel's hands


