Confession of Sin

Minister: Let us confess our sins together.

We plead for your mercy based on the merit of our Lord Jesus Christ alone. Restore to us the joy of salvation and grant to us new obedience. Amen.

I Will Glory In My Redeemer

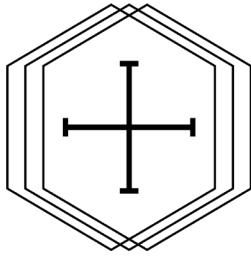
I will glory in my Redeemer

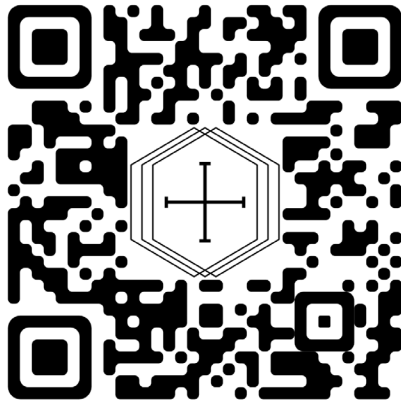
