Call to Confession Psalm 32:3-5

Know that the Lord is God indeed He formed us all without our aid We are the flock He surely feeds The sheep who by His hand He made


O enter then His gates with joy Within His courts His praise proclaim Let faithful songs your tongues employ O bless and magnify His name
