Christ our hope in life and death

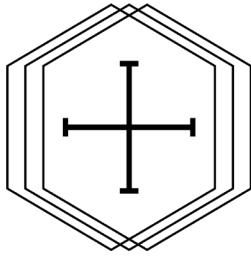
What truth can calm the troubled soul

And we will feast in endless joy, When Christ is ours forevermore

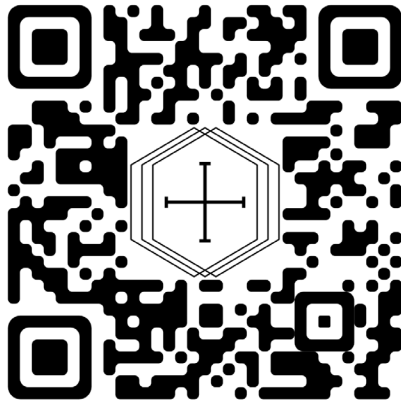
