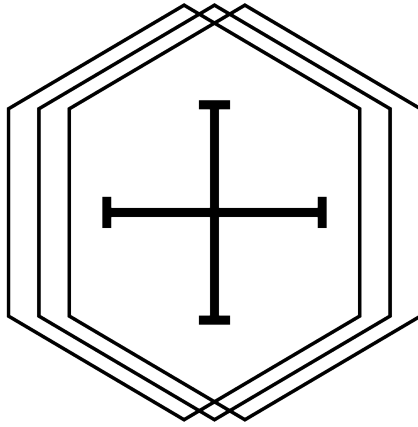

Affirmation of Faith

Westminster Shorter Catechism Q&A 104-106

Minister: What do we pray for in the fourth petition?

All: In the fourth petition, which is, "Give us this day our daily bread," we pray, that of God's free gift we may receive a competent portion of the good things of this life, and enjoy his blessing with them.

Minister: What do we pray for in the fifth petition?

All: In the fifth petition, which is, "And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors," we pray, that God, for Christ's sake, would freely pardon all our sins; which we are the rather encouraged to ask, because by his grace we are enabled from the heart to forgive others.

Minister: What do we pray for in the sixth petition?

All: In the sixth petition, which is, "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil," we pray, that God would either keep us from being tempted to sin, or support and deliver us when we are tempted.

Confession of Sin

The Lamb Who is my righteousness

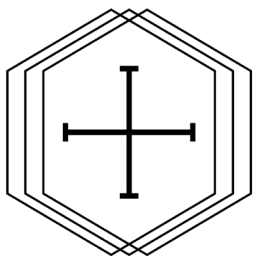
I will glory in my Redeemer

His triumph song I'll ever sing

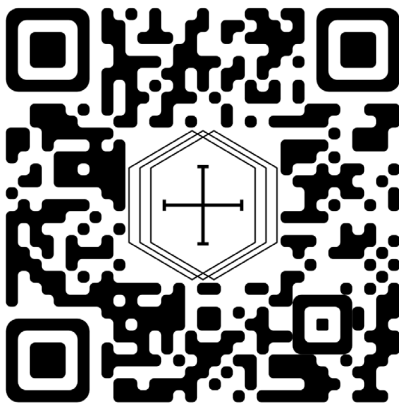
