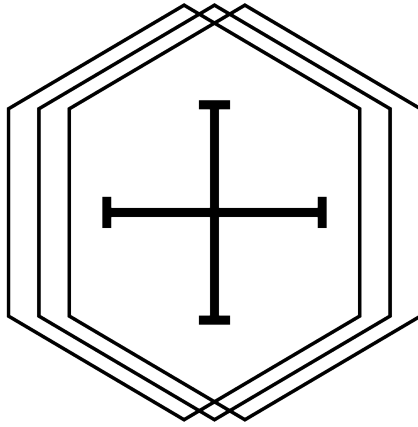

For excellent are they who live as holy in Your sight

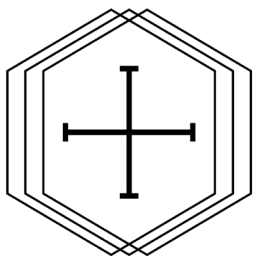
Those seeking other gods shall multiply their pain

My body, too, will rest secure in hope unwavering

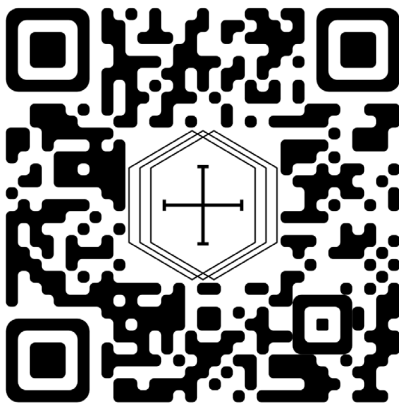
For You will not forsake my soul unto the grave
