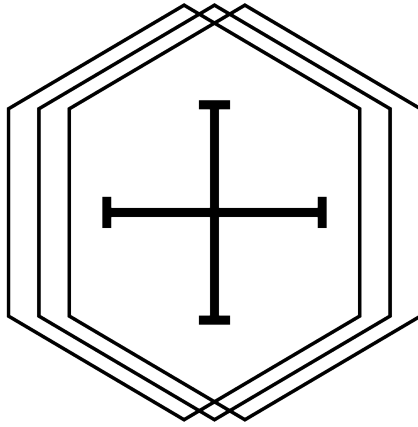

Affirmation of Faith

WCF 8.2 & John 1:1, 14

Minister: What do we believe about the Son of God, Jesus Christ?

All: The Son of God, the second person in the Trinity, being very and eternal God, of one substance, and equal with the Father, did, when the fullness of time was come, take upon him man's nature, with all the essential properties, and common infirmities thereof, yet without sin; being conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, in the womb of the virgin Mary, of her substance.

So that two whole, perfect, and distinct natures, the Godhead and the manhood, were inseparably joined together in one person, without conversion, composition, or confusion. Which person is very God, and very man, yet one Christ, the only mediator between God and man.

All: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God...And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth."

Call to Confession

1 John 1:8-10

Minister: Let us confess our sins together.

And grant that we may hereafter live a godly righteous, and somber life, to the glory of your holy name. Amen.

O may Your eyes the right see and set me free from blame

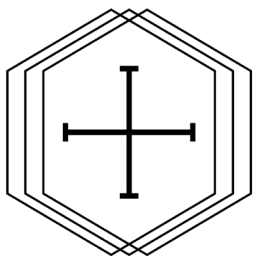
By night You came and sought me, You searched my heart and mind

Protect me from the violent who press on ev'ry side

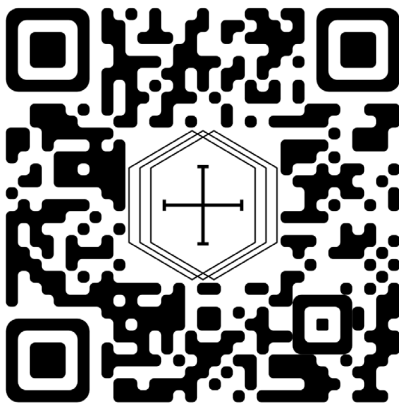
You fill their life with treasure, their sons are satisfied
