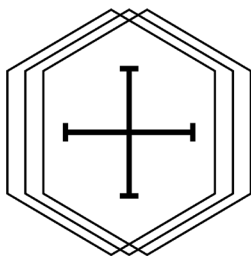
Surely you are not a God
