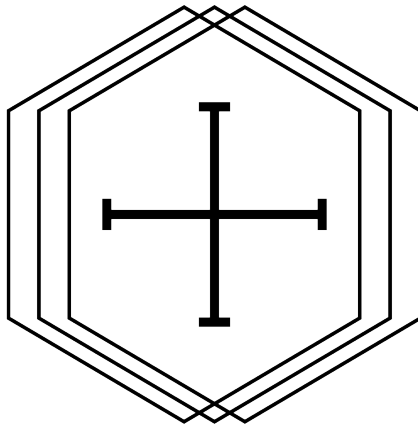

Call to Confession

Psalm 32:3-5

Confession of Sin

Minister: Let us confess our sins together.

We too often ask you to bless what we do, rather than seeking to do what you bless. Forgive us for seeking concessions when we should be seeking guidance. Help us to meet you here, that we might bow before your unspeakable majesty and so live for you now and ever in Christ. Amen.

May the name of God be blest

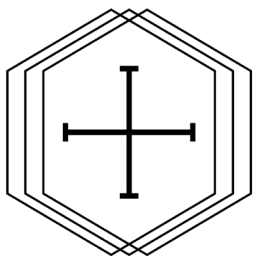
Far above the nations high

Hallelujah! Praise the LORD!

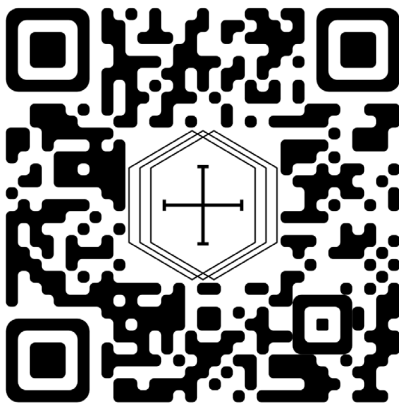
