Save from wrath and make me pure

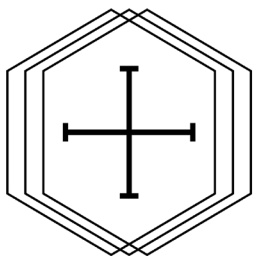
Not the labors of my hands
