Call to Confession

James 2:8-10

"If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing well. Confession of Sin

Minister: Let us confess our sins together.

All: Holy Lord, I have sinned times without number. I have been guilty of pride and unbelief, of failure to find your mind in your Word, and of neglect to seek you in my daily life. My transgressions and shortcomings present me with a list of accusations, but I bless you that they will not stand against me, for all have been laid on Christ. 
