The Sufficiency of Christ  
“Sensual & Emotional Sins: Dead!”  
Colossians 3: 5 - 9  
*Sunday Morning, February 22, 2015*

Introduction:

- I. We must \_\_\_\_\_ ourselves dead to sensual sins (vs. 5)
  - A. We must make a conscious effort to guide against things that appeal to the “flesh.”
    - 1. Immorality
    - 2. Impurity
    - 3. Passion
    - 4. Evil desire
    - 5. Greed = idolatry
  
- II. God’s \_\_\_\_\_ judgment is against sensual sins. (vs. 6, 7)
  - A. We have compelling reasons to avoid sensual sins.
    - 1. God’s wrath is against the “sons of disobedience.”
    - 2. We once lived in them, but now in Christ we have died to them
  
- III. We must also \_\_\_\_\_ ourselves dead to social sins (v. 8, 9)
  - A. We must make a deliberate effort to guide against emotional sins
    - 1. Anger
    - 2. Wrath
    - 3. Malice
    - 4. Slander
    - 5. Abusive speech
    - 6. Lying
  
  - B. We have strong motivation to avoid emotional sins
    - 1. We have put off the “old self.”
    - 2. Its practice should no longer have a hold on us.
