**Scripture passages of the day**--In a *Where's Waldo* book, if you hunt, you can find Waldo on every page. Similarly, Jesus can be found throughout the Bible, or as Sally Lloyd-Jones puts it, "Every story whispers his name." Jesus himself explained on the road to Emmaus that the Scriptures point to him. As you read the first passage of each day, pay attention to what you notice, especially about Jesus. After reading the second passage, think about how it relates to the first passage. As you search Scripture for the greatest gift, remember that sometimes he is physically present, sometimes a person is a type of Jesus, and sometimes, the Biblical writers use things or roles as metaphors or titles for him.

**Hymn of the week**--enjoy singing this daily with your family. See the linked lyrics and YouTube playlist.

**Artwork of the week**--look closely at the piece with your family, noticing the big picture and the details. Put the picture away and take turns sharing what you saw. Then look at the piece again.

**Memory verse of the week**--repeat this daily with your family.
