Kindergarten-6 grade

Del Rey Parochial School recognizes students are at a grammar stage of the trivium and will teach the common subjects in keeping with California Educational Code §51210. Subjects to be taught at the grammar stage are English (literature, reading, speaking, listening, spelling, handwriting and composition), mathematics, social sciences (geography, history), science, fine arts, health, and physical education. Students of DRPA will also study Bible which will include catechism and Scripture memory

All students will be enrolled in Classical Conversations and follow the prescribed curriculum as a core foundation for their studies. It is encouraged that all students be enrolled in a CC community because there are many learning benefits that come from studying in a community/classroom setting with a variety of tutors. Classical Conversations is an excellent base for academics but does need to be supplemented because it is not comprehensive.
