The Sovereignty Of God

The sovereignty of God is the fact that he is the Lord and King over all creation; as sovereign, he exercises his infinite governance and rule. This rule is exercised through God's authority as king, his control over all things, and his presence, power, provision with his covenantal people and throughout his creation. The divine name, Yahweh, expresses this sovereign rule over against the claims of human kings, such as Pharaoh (Exod. 3:14). Because God is tri-personal, however, his sovereign control is not impersonal or mechanical, but is the loving and gracious oversight of the king of creation and redemption. God is sovereign.




The Name Yahweh-Elohim for the Sovereign God.

• The Name Yahweh-Elohim is LORD God in Hebrew and denotes absolute rule of the heavens and the earth and everything in them.

Psalm 47:8

• **God reigns** over the nations; **God** sits on His holy throne.



To know God as sovereign

 It is vital to know the Lord God- Father, Son and Holy Spirit as your sovereign King and Lord not just know about him. This is what it means to be a Christian. This is not a theological issue only but a relational issues



God is Sovereign in creation. He is before all things Colossians 1:16–17

 For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together

God made all things and therefore He is the Sovereign Creator.

John 1:3

• All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

<u>Acts 7:50</u>

- Has My hand not made all these things?'
 <u>1 Corinthians 15:28</u>
- Now when all things are made subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be subject to Him who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all.

God sustains and upholds all things

Hebrews 1:3

- who being the brightness of *His* glory and the express image of His person, and **upholding** all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,
- <u>Colossians 1:17</u>
- And He is before **all things**, and in Him **all things** consist.
- <u>1 Corinthians 8:6</u>
- yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom are all things, and through whom we live.

God transcends all things. He is above all things

Psalm 47:2

• For the LORD **Most High** *is* awesome; *He is* a great King over all the earth.

Psalm 57:2

• I will cry out to God **Most High**, To God who performs *all things* for me.

Psalm 97:9

• For You, LORD, *are* **most high** above all the earth; You are exalted far above all gods.

God knows all things even the secrets of the heart

Psalm 44:21

• Would not **God** search this out? For He **knows** the secrets of the heart.

Romans 8:27

 Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit *is*, because He makes intercession for the saints according to *the will of* God.

• <u>1 John 3:20</u>

• For if our heart condemns us, **God** is greater than our heart, and **knows** all things.

With God, all things are possible. He cannot do things contrary to His nature.

Matthew 19:26

 But Jesus looked at *them* and said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

 Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

 But Jesus looked at them and said, "With men it is impossible, but not with God; for with God all things are possible."

God owns all things

God Is in Control of all things

- But our God *is* in **he**aven; **He** does whatever **He pleases**.

God is in control of all authority

Romans 13:

Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no **authority** except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God.

<u>John 5:27</u>

and has given Him **authority** to execute judgment also, because He is the Son of Man.

John 17:2

as You have given Him **authority** over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him. God rules over the kingdom of men

Daneil 4v17

 That the Most High rules in the kingdom of men, Gives it to whomever He will, And sets over it the lowest of men.' God has control over principalities and powers of darkness

Colossians 1:16

 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

Colossians 2:15

• Having disarmed **principalities** and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.

• <u>Romans 8:38</u>

 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, The Cross was an act of Gods sovereign will

Ephesians 1:4

 just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

1 Corinthians 2:8

 which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

Romans 8:29

• For whom He **foreknew**, He also predestined *to be* conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

God is sovereign even over our decisions

Proverbs 16:33

• The lot is cast into the lap, but its every decision is from the LORD.

Job 31:4

• Does He not see **my ways**, And count all **my** steps?

<u>Isaiah 55:9</u>

"For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts.

God's will cannot be thwarted

• Even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him.


<u>1 Peter 2:9</u>
