


### The Name of the Eternal God El-Olam

**El Olam** means The Everlasting God, The God of Eternity, The God of the Universe, The God of Ancient Days. "Abraham planted a tamarisk tree in Beersheba, and there he called upon the name of the LORD, the Eternal God." (Genesis 21:33). "Trust in the LORD forever, for the LORD, the LORD, is the Rock eternal." (Isaiah 26:4). "Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God." (Psalms 90:2). God's sovereignty extends through the passing of time and beyond our ability to see or understand.

#### **Revelation 1v12-18**

<sup>12</sup> Then I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands, <sup>13</sup> and in the midst of the seven lampstands One like the Son of Man, clothed with a garment down to the feet and girded about the chest with a golden band. <sup>14</sup> His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire; <sup>15</sup> His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His voice as the sound of many waters; <sup>16</sup> He had in His right hand seven stars, out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword, and His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength. <sup>17</sup> And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. But He laid His right hand on me, saying to me, "Do not be afraid; I am the First and the Last. <sup>18</sup> I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. # The Eternal plan of salvation


#### 1 Corinthians 2 v7-v9

### God's Covenants Last forever

### **1 Chronicles 16:15**

Remember His covenant forever,

### Genesis 17:7

 And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you.

God cannot change because he is infinitely perfect in all ways

 God is and has always been and always will be completely perfect in all His attributes and characteristics and therefore he cannot improve, deteriorate or change.

### **Deuteronomy 32:4**

• He is the Rock, His work is **perfect**; For all His ways are justice, A God of truth and without injustice; Righteous and upright is He.

God cannot change because He is God and He is perfect.

 God cannot change because that would mean He is not holy or perfect, and therefore he has no need to change. You cannot change absolute perfection and that is the true eternal nature of God. God is "unchangeable in his being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth." Our Lord is immutable—His character and being can experience no change or mutation. God cannot grow more or less powerful. He can never cease to be holy, just, good, or true. His wisdom and knowledge cannot be increased decreased.

God cannot change because of His omniscience and omipotence

 God cannot change because of His other attributes of being all wise and infinitely powerful and has no need to change. I find joy in every day, not because life is always good, but because God is.

God is eternal and unchangeable this is why we can completely trust him for everything
