Psalm 107 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for He is good! For His Mercy endures forever. ² Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy, ³ And gathered out of the lands, From the east and from the west, From the north and from the south.



The word redemption in biblical terms means- to buy something back for a price, pay the ransom, rescue and deliver- someone or something, save from slavery.

Jesus Christ paid the price (redeemed us) with his own blood on the Cross for the penalty for our sins. He delivered us from the slavery of sin, sinful mankind, self and Satan that we might be His Bride, He is our kinsman redeemer.




The Hebrew word for Redeemer-is gaal- means to redeem, act as kinsman redeemer, buy back from slavery, claim, a close relative- Leviticus 25v 25-48 & 27 and Ruth give us a picture of the kinsman redeemer.

Examples of Redemption in the Old Testament

Exodus 6v6- God Redeems Israel- Therefore say to the children of Israel: 'I *am* the LORD; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will **redeem** you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.

Leviticus 25v25- Kinsman Redeemer- If one of your brethren becomes poor, and has sold *some* of his possession, and if his **redeem**ing relative comes to **redeem** it, then he may **redeem** what his brother sold.



The Three Greek words for Redemption are:

1. Lutron- to release by paying a ransom, to redeem- Luke 24v21, Titus 2v14, 1 Peter 1v18

- 2. Exagoradzo- to buy up, rescue from loss, I buy out, buy away from, ransom; I purchase out, buy, redeem, choose.- Galatians 3v13, 4v5
- Apolilutrosis- deliver, buy back, save, purchase for a price- Hebrew 11v35



Examples of Redemption in the Old Testament

Deuteronomy 7v8- **Redeemed out of Egypt- slavery to (Satan)**- but because the LORD loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, the LORD has brought you out with a mighty hand, and **redeem**ed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 21v8- **Provide atonement**, O LORD, for Your people Israel, whom You have **redeem**ed, and do not lay innocent blood to the charge of Your people Israel.' And atonement shall be provided on their behalf for the blood.

Ruth 4v4 And I thought to ^[b]inform you, saying, 'Buy *it* back in the presence of the inhabitants and the elders of my people. If you will redeem *it*, redeem *it*; but if ^[c]you will not redeem *it*, *then* tell me, that I may know; for *there is* no one, but you to redeem *it*, and I *am* next after you.' "


And he said, "I will redeem it."



WHAT HAVE WE BEEN REDEEMED FROM?

We have been purchased by the Blood of Jesus from the slavery of-

- Sin- <u>Romans 3:25</u>- whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed,
- Satan- Revelation 12v 11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.
- Self Ephesians 2v4 But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), 6 and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, 7 that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.
- Sinful men- <u>1 Corinthians 7:23</u> You were bought at a price; do not become slaves of men.




HOW ARE WE REDEEMED?

Redeemed by Grace through faith in the propitiation by His blood shed for us on the Cross.

We are Redeemed by faith though the Blood of Jess Christ shed on the Cross.

Romans 3-v23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ being justified ^[g]freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, ²⁵ whom God set forth *as* a ^[h]propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed,


Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart Be acceptable in Your sight, O LORD, my strength and my **Redeemer**.

JESUS IS OUR REDEEMER

Anna Bears Witness to the Redeemer- Luke 2

³⁶ Now there was one, Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was of a great age and had lived with a husband seven years from her virginity; ³⁷ and this woman was a widow ^[i] of about eighty-four years, who did not depart from the temple, but served *God* with fasting's and prayers night and day. ³⁸ And coming in that instant she gave thanks to ^[i] the Lord and spoke of Him to all those who looked for redemption in Jerusalem.



JESUS IS OUR REDEEMER

Revelation 5:9- Jesus Our Redeemer

And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have **redeemed** us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,

Galatians 3:13

Christ has **redeemed** us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree"),



WHO IS REDEEMED & WHO IS NOT?

The Redeemed are in Christ and the Unsaved have not been redeemed but still in slavery- John 8:34- Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin."

1 Corinthians 6v9- Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor ^[b]homosexuals, nor ^[c]sodomites, ¹⁰ nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. ¹¹ And such were some of you. <u>But you were washed, but you were ^[d]sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.</u>



WHEN ARE WE REDEEMED?

We are Redeemed when we put our faith and trust in the one whom redeems us even Jesus Christ and in his work of redemption on the Cross.

Romans 6v16 Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are that one's slaves whom you obey, whether of sin *leading* to death, or of obedience *leading* to righteousness? ¹⁷ But God be thanked that *though* you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were ^[e]delivered. ¹⁸ And having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness.

WHAT ARE WE REDEEMED FROM?

Trained by Saving Grace- Titus 2- Redeemed from Lawless Deeds


^{v11} For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, ¹² teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, ¹³ looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, ¹⁴ who gave Himself for us, that He might <u>redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself *His* own special people, zealous for good works.</u>

Redeemed from the curse of the Law- Gal 3v10 - For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, "Cursed [is] everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them."

Redeemed for Sin- Romans 6:22

But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life.



Ephesians 1- Our redemption is the guarantee of our inheritance in Christ.

¹³ In Him you also *trusted*, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, ¹⁴ who^[d] is the ^[e]guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.



Exodus 6:6








THE PURPOSE OF REDEMPTION


